Thanks for purchasing the **Ultimate Mixing** pack. Below is all the information you need to install the chains in Logic Pro X.



This pack contains the following 50+ custom designed processing chains for Audio Tracks in Logic. This includes bespoke **EQ, compression, saturation, reverbs, delays** and more.

These chains contain presets, and like all presets, they should be treated as a starting point to help you build a great mix. I've built these chains based on scenarios that I've come across over years of mixing and I encourage you to tweak the presets to taste and make them work for you.

The chains were built using Logic Pro X 10.7.2 and I recommend you have updated to this version of Logic before installing..

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

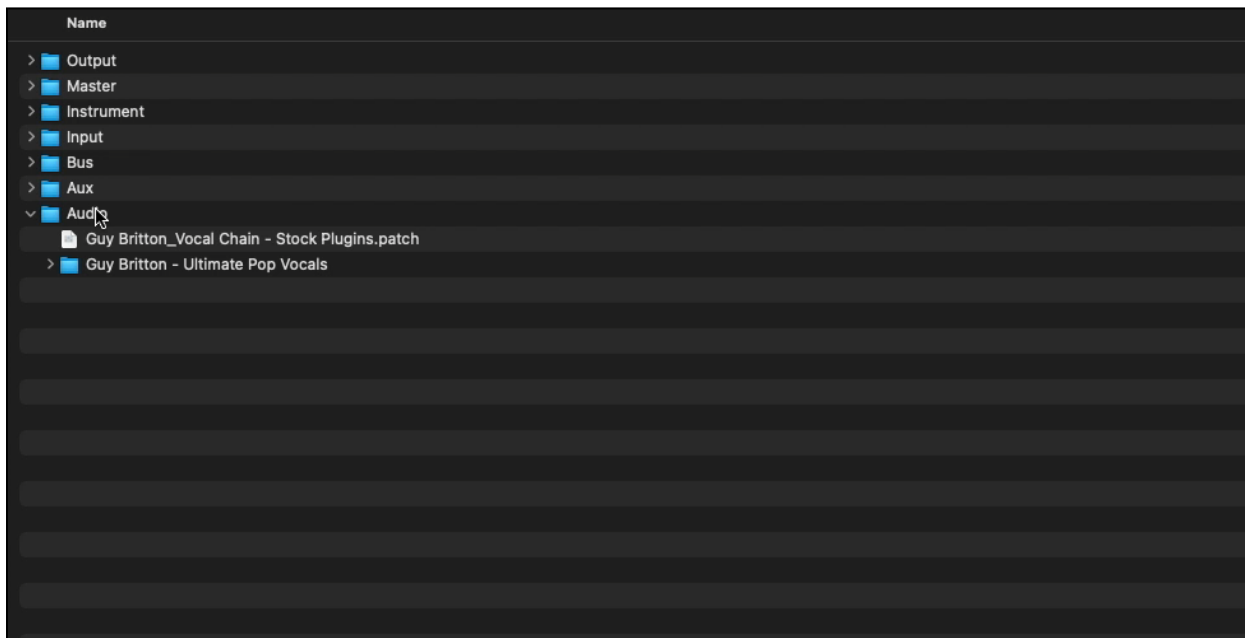
STEP 1 OF 3

Extract the ZIP file “Guy Britton - Ultimate Mixing” and press Copy on the folder containing the instrument sub-folders.



STEP 2 OF 3

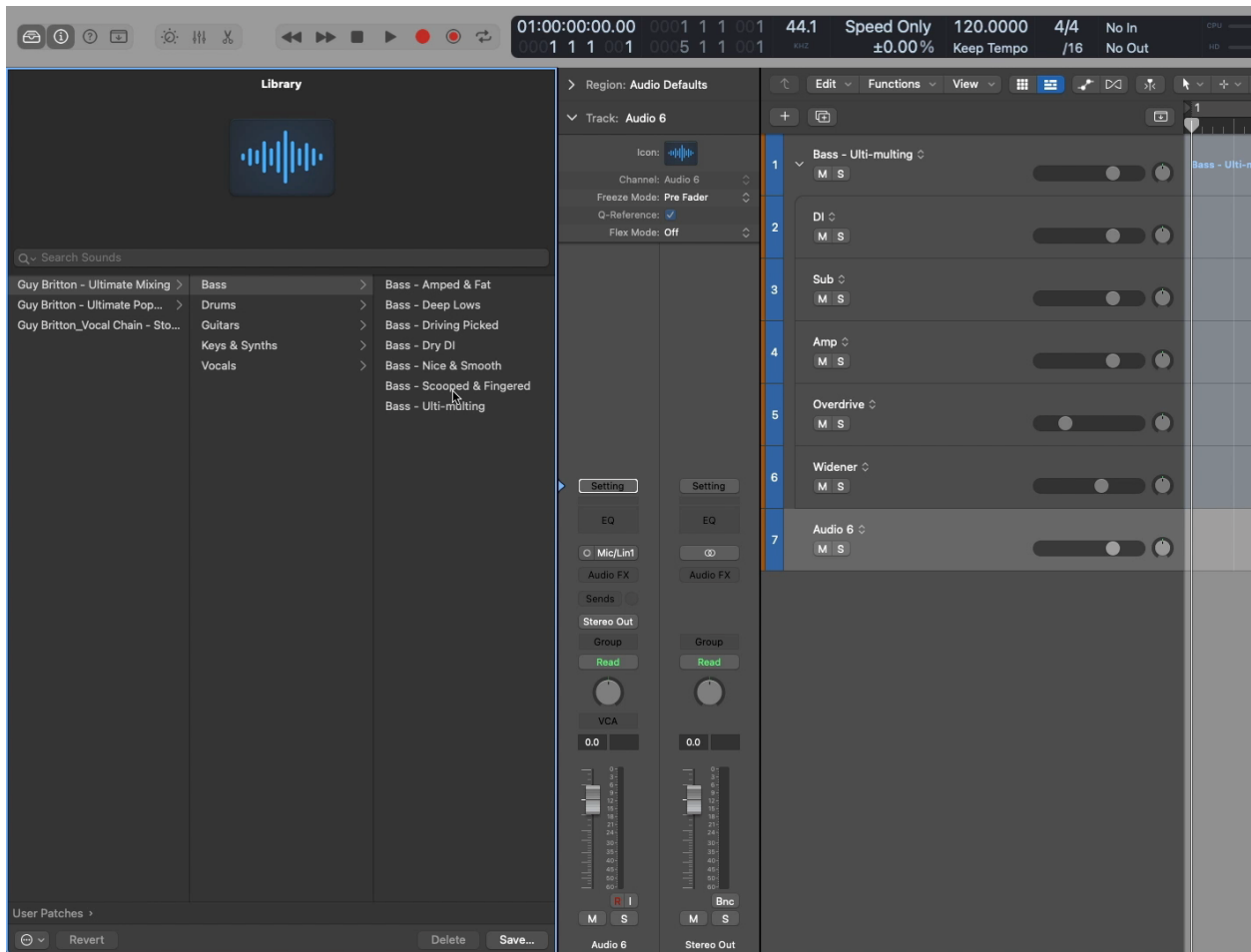
Locate the **Audio Music Apps** folder for Logic's Patches and then select the 'Audio' folder. In most cases this is located under *Music > Audio Music Apps > Patches > Audio*



Paste the copied folder into the 'Audio' folder here.

STEP 3 OF 3

In Logic Pro X, create or select an **Audio Track**, open the Library (or press Y on the keyboard) and the chains should now appear in Logic under the 'User Presets'.



Click a chain to load it onto the audio track.
