Thanks for purchasing the Ultimate Vocal Chains - Slate Edition pack. Below is all the information you need to install the vocal chains in Virtual Mix Rack.



Firstly, please make sure you have an up-to-date version of [Virtual Mix Rack](#) installed along with the following modules:

AirEQ Air, CS-EQ, Custom Opto, FG-116 (Vintage, Modern, Standard), FG-2A, FG-401, FG-73, FG-A, FG-DS 902, FG-Dynamics, FG-N, FG-S, FG-Stress, Gate: Classic, Hollywood, London & New York (Virtual Tube Collection), Revival, Trimmer, U73b

This pack contains 10 custom designed vocal processing chains for Virtual Mix Rack. This includes bespoke **EQ, compression, saturation, de-essing** and more.

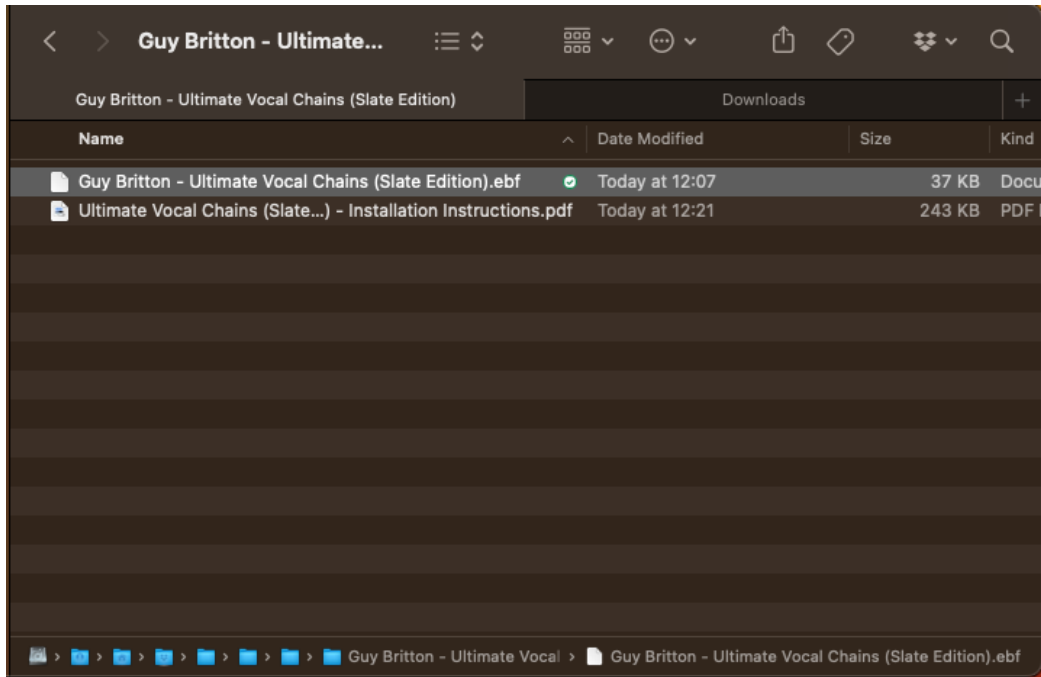
These vocal chains contain presets, and like all presets, they should be treated as a starting point to inspire a great vocal sound. Every vocal is different and depends completely on the performance, the microphone, the preamp used, the room it was recorded in - there are countless factors that make up a vocal sound! I've built these chains based on scenarios that I've come across over years of mixing pop music. I encourage you to tweak the presets to taste and make them work for you.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

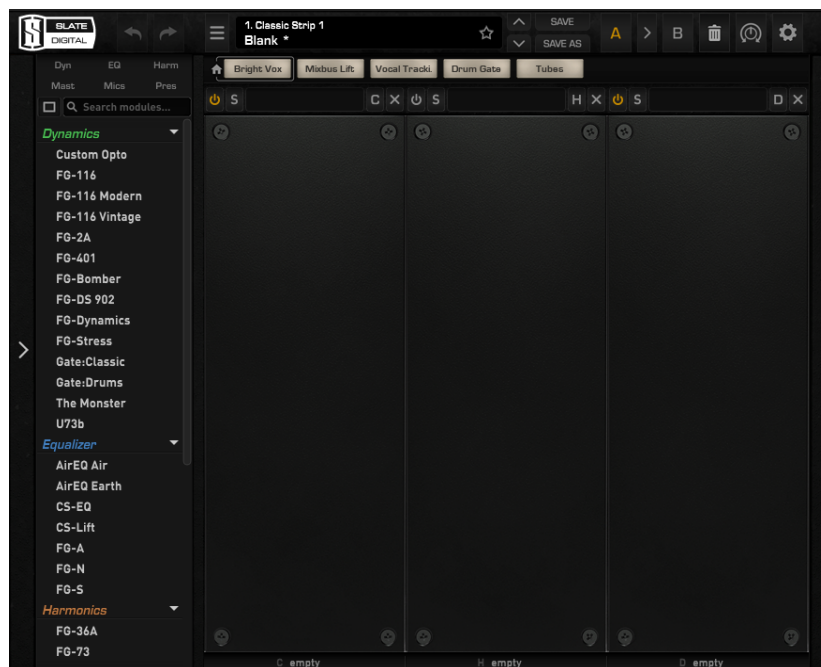
STEP 1 OF 4

Extract the ZIP file “Guy Britton - Ultimate Vocal Chains (Slate Edition)” and locate the file “*Guy Britton - Ultimate Vocal Chains (Slate Edition).ebf*”. This .ebf contains the vocal chains which will be loaded into VMR. I would recommend copying this to a safe location where you keep the rest of your installation files / plugins / presets.



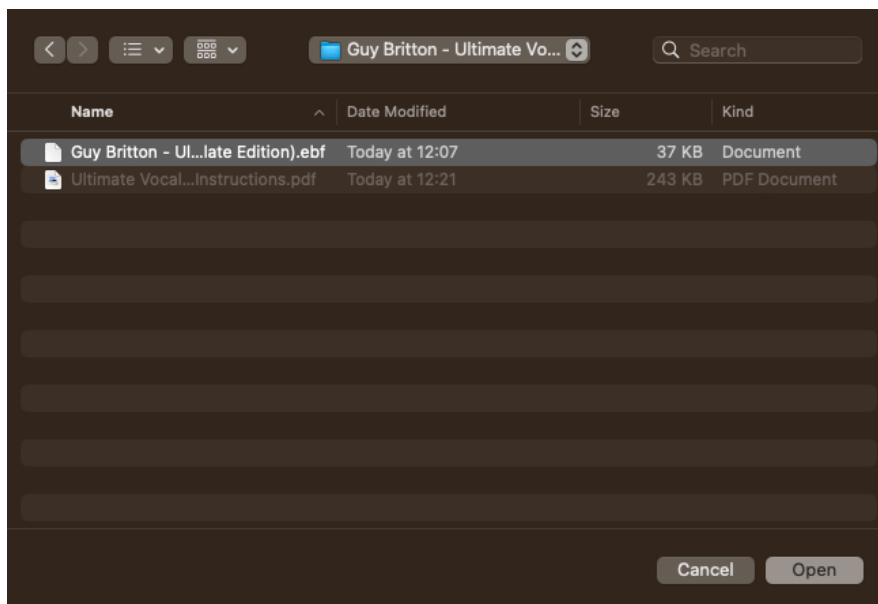
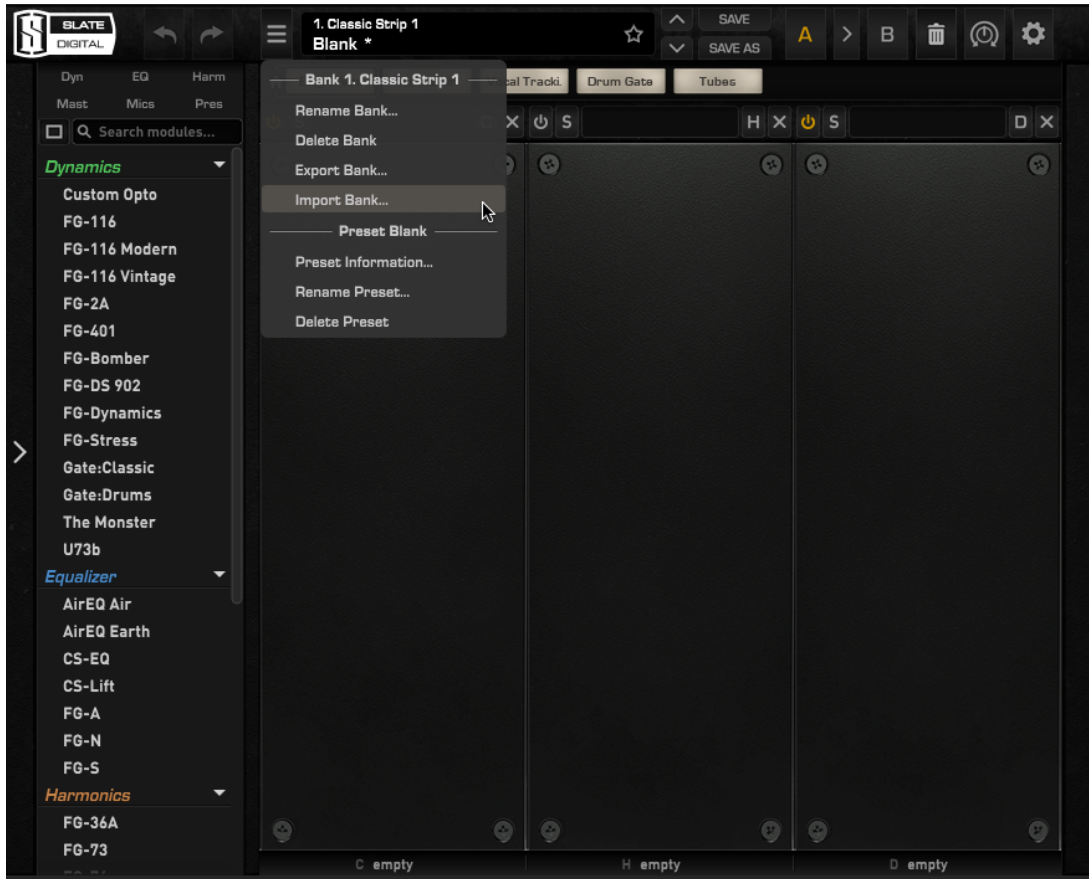
STEP 2 OF 4

Open your DAW and insert an instance of Virtual Mix Rack on the desired channel.



STEP 3 OF 4

Within the VMR plug-in window, click the icon with the three lines next to the default preset name. This opens the menu. In the menu, press 'Import Bank' and then locate the file "Guy Britton - Ultimate Vocal Chains (Slate Edition).ebf" and press Open.



STEP 4 OF 4

Once you have imported the .ebf file, click on the preset name at the top of VMR and 'Guy Britton - Ultimate Vocal Chains (Slate Edition)' should now appear in the preset menu. Navigate down to this and you should now be able to load any of the presets from here.
